This position is 1x Full time position 40 hrs per week and 1x Part time position 20 hours per week 0.5 FTE.

Both experienced audiologists (preferably in paediatric audiology) and new graduates are welcome to apply. Full supervision will be provided as required. Overseas candidates are also welcome to apply. The Audiology service provides comprehensive diagnostic and rehabilitative audiology services to all age groups, based from Wellington Regional and Kenepuru Community Hospitals.
